### PEFC Certification

Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC)

Finsa MDF products are PEFC-certified, ensuring the wood is sourced from sustainably managed forests and controlled sources.

### CARB2 Compliance

California Air Resources Board Phase 2 (CARB2)

Finsa MDF complies with CARB2 standards for formaldehyde emissions—among the strictest in the world.

Emission Level:  $\leq 0.11$  ppm (parts per million)

Helps reduce indoor air pollution and supports healthier indoor environments.

### E1 Classification (EN 13986 / EN 622-5)

European formaldehyde emission standard.

Finsa MDF meets or exceeds E1 class limits, with formaldehyde emissions  $\leq 0.124$  mg/m<sup>3</sup>.

### Moisture Resistance (EN 622-5)

Finsa Hidrófugo MDF is classified as Type MDF:H (moisture-resistant MDF), meeting the requirements for humid environments (e.g. kitchens, bathrooms).

### Environmental Product Declaration (EPD)

Finsa has published EPDs in accordance with ISO 14025 and EN 15804 standards, documenting the environmental impact across the full product lifecycle (from raw material extraction to disposal).
